

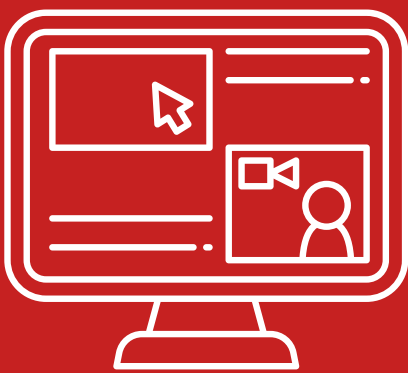
TREATMENT 101 FOR PUBLIC SAFETY PERSONNEL

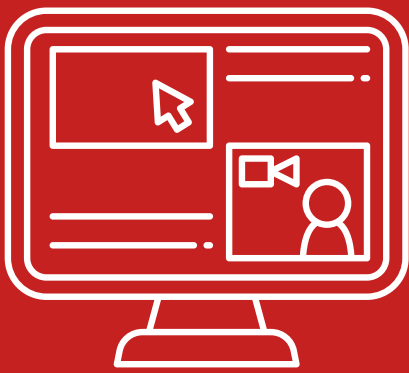
